Dear St. James Wood Property Owners,

This year the POA has plans for continued improvement to the landscape of the entrances, cul de sac islands and the park. We have no plans for new major projects to the St James Wood common grounds. We completed all of the irrigation projects two years ago and we have most of the islands turned around and are working on making sure they are all properly and regularly maintained. This effort is reflected in the increase of the Landscape line of the budget on the next page. We have increased spending in this area each of the past 4 years and for the first time this increase has meant that we had to reduce other line items on the budget below where we would like to keep them. We can still cover all of the events that normally come up. Any unexpected major events will be covered with our common area improvements reserve funds.

In the future we will have to increase the annual dues. We will seek input from property owners this year to see which path the homeowners would like to pursue. For example: Is a single sizable increase preferred? That way we don't have to increase it again for another 10 years, or would regular smaller increases to keep pace with inflation be preferred? Please share your thoughts on our website portal via "contact us." send an email to us or a letter to our PO Box. You can call one of us to discuss as well, however it is much easier for the trustees to review as a group if your input is sent in writing.

Please use our website for information regarding leaf pick-up, Sylvania Township News, major road construction project updates, and to check if your dues are paid as well as download next years invoice and verify where to mail payment. We are finding that if we keep the info on the website current it is one of the best means of communication. If you are looking for deed restrictions & other documents they are usually found in the "file library". (Sometimes you have to dig deep in the menu, but it's all there)

Sylvania Township Road Department will be resurfacing many streets in St James this year. Be aware and keep the street clear for them so that they can get in done as well and smoothly as possible.

Brush Pick-up:

For brush pickup please keep your brush and leaves separated. Look at the Sylvania Township website to see when they will be picking up in our area. Put items at the curb shortly before the posted dates so that we don't have leaves and brush in the streets all year.

These pick-ups are intended to pickup the normal fallen debris from the fall and winter.

Exterior Remodeling & Painting:

Please send us your plans if you are remodeling the exterior of your home. It's so much easier for everyone if you keep the colors consistent with the deed restrictions. Copies of deed restrictions can be found on our website in the file library.

Garbage:

Please remember to put your garbage out no earlier than 7pm the night before pick-up and bring them in promptly afterwards. Travelling?? Ask your neighbors to help. It's better for everyone to not give signs that a home might be vacant. Help each other.
