Dear St. James Wood Property Owners,

In the future we have a planned replacement schedule for the structures on our common grounds. The playground equipment in the park was replaced in 2012 and the next items on the list are the entrances. We plan to redesign all neighborhood entranceways to create a modern and consistent appearance which includes new stone, lighting, and signage as well as fix aging sidewalks along the park. This is necessary in order to stay consistent with surrounding neighborhoods as well as maintain an updated look that will continue to improve property values. As it stands, annual dues have not been raised in over ten years and will need to increase to cover inflation. Last year we asked if people wanted to do a significant increase to be able to accelerate the rate of updating and avoid having to raise dues again for another 10 years. The final tally of the vote was 246 yes and 244 votes no and 275 households did not respond. This was not enough yes votes to pass that proposed increase last fall. We expect that we will need to increase the dues to \$70.00 in the next 2 years. Dues have not been increased since 2007, and the increase will still keep us below area neighborhoods. 






As time gets closer watch our web-

## SYLVANIA TOWNSHIP NEWS - ROAD DEPARTMENT Leaf Pick-up: STARTS AFTER OCTOBER 3rd, 2018

Please remove all brush and leaves from the street until after Oct. 3. These items can be recycled at two locations nearby:

- 1.) Clean Wood Recycling, 419-843-9663. 6505 West Bancroft Street, between Interstate I-475 and McCord Road.
- 2.) A&J Landscape, 419-842-8733. 8061 Sylvania Avenue, between King Road and Centennial.

For brush pickup please keep your brush and leaves separated. Look at the Sylvania Township website to see when they will be picking up in our area. Put items at the curb shortly before the posted dates so that we don't have leaves and brush in the streets all year.

These pick-ups are intended to pickup the normal fallen debris from the fall and winter.

## 2018 Household Pickup

September 10, 2018

The Household Pickup service is limited to the following items: Bikes

Books / Paper - must be bundled Carpeting, cut and rolled no longer than 5 feet Containers / Drums - must be empty Appliances, without refrigerants Furniture, mattress & box springs (legs over 12" separated) Miscellaneous (non-hazardous) loose material placed in a disposal container.

Do not mix with brush or leafs. Removal of all other items is NOT provided with this service.

## Garbage:

Please remember to put your garbage out no earlier than 7pm the night before pick-up and bring them in promptly afterwards. Travelling?? Ask your neighbors to help. It's better for everyone to not give signs that a home might be vacant. Help each other.

Garbage cans are to be kept inside the garage and out of site from the road except during pick-up hours.
