News from Sylvania Township...

Residential Road Resurfacing: The Township's residential road resurfacing program swings into full gear during the spring and will continue throughout the summer and fall seasons. Funding for this work is provided by the capital improvement fund; there are no assessments to property owners. This project consists of several miles of milling and resurfacing with minor base repair and other related work during the summer of 2012:
